## Approval of Minutes

Councilman Jerry Mauldin made a motion to approved August council meeting minutes. Motion seconded by Councilman Fain. All in favor.

## Announcements \& Updates

- Only incumbents qualified for the 2 council positions so no election will be held. Swearing in will be held January $4^{\text {th }}, 2022$ at the first meeting of the new year.
- The City has received the draft permit for our water pollution control plant. A copy is available at city hall for review and comment by the public. At the end of the 30-day period a new permit will be issued. All changes and procedures added by EPD must be adhered to by the city.
- Both electric sewer pump has failed leaving us with a diesel standby pump. An emergency valve was installed only 2 days prior to the pump failure. The standby pump failed one time since.


## New Business

- Review 2022 budget. Modify or accept as is.

Councilman Fain made a motion to accept the $1^{\text {st }}$ reading of the budget. Motion seconded by Councilman Junior Holsomback. All in favor.

- Review Millage rate. Set rate for 2022.

Councilman Fain made a motion to keep/set the millage rate at 5.747. Motion seconded by Councilman Billy Mauldin. All in favor.

- Review account balances, questions or concerns?

Council reviewed the account balances. No motion was made.

- Pickens County increased rate ( $\mathbf{0 . 1 2}$ per thousand gallons) for our water purchase.

Due to increase by Pickens County and increase maintenance cost the council decided to increase water rates.
Councilman Jerry Mauldin made a motion to increase the water rate to .20 cents per thousand gallons. Motion seconded by Councilman Fain. All in favor.

- First payment made to contractor for sewer renovation project. Copy enclosed in packet. No motion was made.
