- *City received \$16,877.80 for 2024 LMIG project – Peachtree Street.*
- *Routine Maintenance and repairs being done at the park. Mayor warned if anyone caught doing doughnuts on the field – they will be prosecuted.*
- *Job opening for Library will close March 8th.*
- *Fence has been removed from the park.*
- *Talking with DOT on Solar powered RRFB (rectangular rapid flashing beacon). Cost around 8-9K for pair. One on each side of 411*
- *Still working on flashing speed signs to correct speed.*
- *The 4 dead trees have been removed and cleaned up.*
- *We are still in engineer stages for water tower for The Ridge. (what do we think it needs to service besides existing customers and expected growth of subdivision or reserve).*

New Business

1. Consider putting up RRFB’s once the TE (traffic engineering report) Study is completed. Fain asked about grants from State or use of funds from speed camera tickets. Mayor advised will check on funding. Steve Fain made motion to move forward with beacons and to possibly use funding, Jerry Mauldin – 2nd. All in Favor.
2. Vote to put Liquor License on ballot? Steve Fain made motion to add to ballot, Billy Mauldin 2nd - 3 ayes.
3. Go over Task Order Agreement for The Ridge engineering & what John’s team will be doing throughout process of the water tower. RJ Wood is the engineer to LGI homes, once Sweitzer approves they can move forward. The TOA (general contract) was signed by Mayor Leamer & Engineer John Sweitzer and is good for 5 years. This gives Sweitzer the OK to approve any other decisions made.
4. Mayor Leamer added it was suggested to fix the baseball field at park before moving forward with any other larger projects. Billy Mauldin advised we need to get quotes before sending out for bid. Jerry Mauldin made motion to move forward with quotes to re-do baseball field. Steve Fain 2nd – All in Favor.

Chad McKinney stood to inform Calhoun has PFA’s in county water which is synthetic chemicals and carcinogenic.
